"BORN-AGAIN POLITICS"

On the front cover of this past week's Newsweek magazine was a picture of the TV evangelist who comes on just ahead of me on our Tucson Channel 11 Sunday mornings. His name is Jerry Falwell, and if I may be forgiven for a harmless pun, he does fall well when it comes to UNDERSTANDING the Word of God!

The big-type red-ink headline atop his pic on Newsweek's front cover is "Born-Again Politics." It reminds me of the poem of sixty years ago: "The barefoot boy with shoes on stood sitting in the grass, and it rained all day that night"--a parody of opposites.

Mr. Falwell is NOT "born again" and has no understanding of what the term MEANS. And if he were, he would never be in politics. When one is born again he would no more be in politics than a barefoot boy would have shoes on his feet--than a boy sitting in the grass would be standing, or than day would be night.

Do I then criticize Mr. Falwell or condemn him? Not at all. Not at all. God is not judging him--yet, and neither do I. But this is an apt illustration, blared before the whole nation on Newsweek's cover, of what did happen to the first man, Adam--and what is consequently the state of ALL in the world today, EXCEPT the very few God has specially called. Humanity has lost sight of all this. The religionists of "traditional Christianity" think they believe the Bible as the Word of God, yet they don't--any more than the barefoot boy has on shoes.

The first man Adam was the father--the progenitor--of the human race. He was required to make a CHOICE between receiving God's Holy Spirit to open his mind to revealed knowledge from God, or taking to himself knowledge of what is good and what is evil. ADAM MADE THE CHOICE FOR MANKIND as a whole--his progeny who would be born from him. He CUT MANKIND OFF FROM GOD, from the Holy Spirit, and thus from revealed KNOWLEDGE from God understandable only through the Spirit of God. All, that is, EXCEPT the minute FEW God would specially call and choose.

God made Adam's decision BINDING on all EXCEPT the very few God would call. That made God RESPONSIBLE, knowing well He was leaving Satan on the throne to DECEIVE mankind. So God BLINDED humanity--left humanity CUT OFF from Him and His KNOWLEDGE U N T I L the second Adam, Jesus Christ, should overcome Satan, qualify to restore God's GOVERNMENT, and Himself be inducted on the throne over the earth.

That means the world is CUT OFF and cannot UNDERSTAND God's knowledge UNTIL the second coming of Christ and the removal of Satan. Meanwhile,

the world is NOT BEING JUDGED. Those in the world uncalled are NOT "lost," neither are they "saved." Just not judged--YET! But this they do not understand.

The leaders of "traditional Christianity" do not seem to know Jesus was born to be a KING. Jesus came to QUALIFY to replace Satan on the THRONE over the earth. If we are called, and chosen by Him, we shall sit with Him in His THRONE over the entire earth. We shall be given divine spiritual POWER to RULE the world with and under Christ, "with a rod of iron."

WHY are we called, now, into God's CHURCH? For a PURPOSE! That purpose is that we, too, through Christ and the Holy Spirit overcome Satan, have our minds opened by God's Spirit to GOD'S KNOWLEDGE (Truth), grow in grace and knowledge, develop spiritual CHARACTER to qualify us to RULE in the Kingdom of God with the restored GOVERNMENT OF GOD over all the earth.

BUT WE ARE NOT called to become part of the GOVERNMENTS of THIS WORLD --manipulated by Satan. This is Satan's world. Those not begotten (not yet BORN) are NOT children of God, THEY ARE CHILDREN OF SATAN (Jesus said so--John 8:44). But when we are called to repentance, faith, and receiving the Holy Spirit, God's Spirit witnesses with our spirit that we are the begotten children of GOD (Rom. 8:16), but until then we are NONE OF CHRIST'S (Rom. 8:9).

IF we are begotten children, not yet BORN, we are like father Abraham, a stranger and pilgrim in this world. Yet not OF this world or its politics. Our real citizenship is reserved in heaven (Phil. 3:20). We are like foreigners and strangers in this world.

MUST WE DWELL IN BOOTHS?

Back in the spring of 1927 God opened my mind to see that not only is the weekly Sabbath binding FOREVER, but the ANNUAL Sabbaths as well. God had not yet revealed to me WHY, I just knew He commanded, and I obeyed. For seven years my wife and I kept these days ALONE. When I made the truth plain to the Sardis brethren in Oregon they laughed me to scorn.

Seven years after my conversion the Philadelphia era of God's Church was raised up, through a six weeks, six-nights-a-week campaign in a one-room country school house near Eugene, Oregon. They were mostly my own new converts. They did listen, and with Mrs. Armstrong and me join in observing them. But it was 12 years later, 1945, when God finally revealed to me the MEANING of His annual Festivals--the real REASON WHY He had commanded them FOR EVER!

God is working out a PURPOSE here on earth! That PURPOSE is dual:
a) God is reproducing Himself--forming future GOD BEINGS from mortal

humans made from material soil, b) restoring the GOVERNMENT of God through these future born children of God.

For this transcendental PURPOSE God has a MASTER PLAN for its accomplishment. There are seven major steps in that Master Plan. The annual Festivals of God PICTURE that Master Plan.

God commanded these Festivals to be kept FOR EVER--WHY? For His CHURCH His purpose and reason is to remind us every year--so we never forget--each of these seven steps in the working out of His Supreme PURPOSE.

Just going through the motions of meeting together on each of the Feasts would not accomplish God's PURPOSE in GIVING us these feasts--IF WE DO NOT PROCLAIM SERMONS TO THE PEOPLE on the MEANING of these Festivals. By two or three years ago many ministers had drifted into preaching on these feasts just whatever subject they themselves liked to speak on--with not a word about the MEANING of the feast God wants the congregations to bear in mind.

In the PAGAN religions, they believe that going through certain motions--doing certain physical things--is the religious duty of people. For example, one branch of "traditional Christianity" is merely a continuation of the ancient BABYLONIAN MYSTERY RELIGION (Rev. 17:5). One motion they go through, for example, is to cross themselves. It is merely a SUPERSTITION. Without actually realizing it, the reason they do this is that they suppose a harsh, stern, angry GOD of some kind is watching. If they don't go through this motion this god will be angry, and they will have bad luck. They think just going through the physical motion will please this false, non-existent god.

But the REAL GOD is a God of LOVE--a God of KNOWLEDGE--of UNDERSTANDING--who wants to develop in us HIS holy, righteous, perfect CHARACTER.

He gave us these annual Feasts to renew yearly in our KNOWLEDGE His Purpose--what He is developing in us!

Now in Old Testament Israel they did not have the Holy Spirit. They could not UNDERSTAND the SPIRITUAL meaning of these Festivals. But the New Testament Church is the FIRST FRUITS--that is, the first GROUP or BODY to receive the Holy Spirit AS A BODY to become the FIRST BORN as finally resurrected and born GOD BEINGS.

Ancient Israel did not understand the MEANING of these Feasts. In them God takes the MATERIAL HARVEST in Judea to picture to His Church annually His SPIRITUAL HARVEST of GOD BEINGS.

True, God ordained the Feasts to be observed FOR EVER. But to ancient Israel--AT THE TIME when they were in the desert BEFORE they entered the Promised Land, God said to them, "Ye shall dwell in booths seven days; all that are Israelites born" (NOT us that are Christians begotten of GOD) "shall dwell in booths."

WHY? "That your generations may know that I made the children of Israel" (NOT the begotten children of GOD) "to dwell in booths," WHEN?

"When I brought them out of the land of Egypt" (Lev. 23:42-43).

They were in a hot climate where they could find branches of certain trees--palm, myrtle and olive branches. Later in Palestine, a part of Israel only (of Judah) under Ezra and Nehemiah used these booths (Neh. 8:14-18). But, for example, myrtle branches are found only in Palestine, and palm and olive branches are found only in some hot climates.

But now the Church, then to be made into the Kingdom of God, ruling the earth, in the time PICTURED TO US BY THE FEAST OF TABERNACLES, will cause ALL NATIONS to go to Jerusalem for this Festival. WHY? To make booths of tree branches and live inside them?--each alone by himself seven days--in order not to DISplease an angry god? NO! But "to worship the KING, the Lord of hosts" (Zech. 14:16).

Jesus observed the Feast of Tabernacles when He was in human flesh on earth. Did He make a booth of tree and shrub branches to dwell in for seven days? NOTICE!

Jesus was in Galilee (John 7:1). The Feast of Tabernacles was at hand (verse 2). His brethren urged Him to depart at once for Jerusalem for the Feast (v. 3). But Jesus remained behind in Galilee for a while (v. 9). But after their departure, Jesus also went up secretly (v. 10). About the middle of the Feast, Jesus went into the Temple (v. 14). He taught the people there. On the last Great Day, Jesus spoke of the Holy Spirit (v. 37-39).

But there is NOT A WORD that Jesus or any of His disciples (future Apostles of the Church made "booths" of tree and shrub branches, or dwelt in them. Jesus met with them IN THE TEMPLE, where He taught and preached. They thus had services--or teaching--in an auditorium--JUST AS WE DO TODAY. We call these meeting halls tabernacles. Jesus and the first Apostles SET US THE EXAMPLE--but there is no evidence or record that they dwelt in booths.

The dwelling in booths was not the PURPOSE or reason for this fall festival.

The Feast of Trumpets is to teach God's people all over again every year about the coming of Christ as KING of kings to RULE THE EARTH! The Day of Atonement was given to keep us in knowledge that Satan shall be taken away so that we may be AT-ONE-MENT with God and with Christ. The Feast of Tabernacles was commanded forever, and is to teach the CHURCH today over and over every year about the MILLENNIAL REIGN OF THE KINGDOM OF GOD OVER THE WHOLE EARTH--with Satan gone--with EVERYONE then living being at last CALLED to judgment and opportunity for eternal salvation.

That is the PURPOSE of the Feast--not gathering branches for a booth to shelter us. Today we have houses and buildings to shelter us.

So we find NO dwelling in booths in the New Testament Church, nor in the millennium AFTER Christ returns!

FROM MINISTERIAL SERVICESPolicy on Ministers Flying Airplanes

Recently we have had several men request permission to fly airplanes in order to reduce the travel time to outlying areas within their circuits. Some feel they can fly for just about the same cost as, or less than, driving; however, in figuring the costs, they don't consider the liability exposure that the Church is open to when they fly a private plane.

Whenever a minister flies on Church business in a private airplane, whether he pilots the plane or someone else does, the Church would be liable for any damages resulting from an accident. This liability is extremely large due to the possibility of crashing into populated areas, etc.

In order to obtain liability insurance coverage, we would have to file a separate report on each pilot giving his health, his flying experience, how much he would be flying, where he would be flying, and so forth.

Because of the cost of insuring the Church against such a large liability exposure, Mr. Armstrong has set the policy that ministers are not to pilot airplanes as a part of their jobs, nor should they have a member or some other private individual fly them on Church business. Ministers should make business flights only with commercial or chartered airlines and then only when the expense for doing so has been approved.

I have discussed this with Mr. Armstrong personally and he was quite alarmed that some men have taken it upon themselves to do this without checking with him first. Mr. Armstrong's feeling, having discussed this with our pilots, is that a man who only flies occasionally wouldn't be experienced enough to be a safe pilot and those who would fly enough to be proficient would be sacrificing their commitment to the ministry. Therefore, it is Mr. Armstrong's decision that ministers should not pilot planes at any time.

International News

Report From New Zealand Christ is continuing to abundantly bless His Work in New Zealand and the South Pacific. Income for August was 24.3% up on the same month last year, and the year-to-date increase now stands at 30.7%.

A glance at our income graph for the past few years is an inspiring sight. For a number of years the income was reasonably stable. Then, suddenly, in January 1979, the very month the receivership crisis broke and Mr. Herbert W. Armstrong stepped in to put God's Work back on the right track, the income leaped up by 30%. And ever since that time it has continued to run at a level of 30% ahead of the previous year!

Figures have now been finalized for our householder card promotion of The PLAIN TRUTH earlier in the year. A total of 5300 cards were returned. This is a response rate of 1%, at a cost-per-response of \$1.80. Householder cards will be distributed to the remaining half of the country in October.

Final figures are also available for our recent newspaper ads in the Pacific Islands. Three hundred and thirty new subscribers were added to The PLAIN TRUTH and La PURE VERITE mailing lists at a cost-per-response of \$4.50.

In the last week of August we placed a full-page ad in the New Zealand Woman's Weekly for the new UNITED STATES AND BRITAIN IN PROPHECY book. Responses are just beginning to come in. The ad will also appear in the same magazine in the first week in September.

We're pleased to report Christ has added another minister in New Zealand. Mr. Dennis Gordon was ordained a Local Elder by Mr. Bob Morton on August 23rd. Mr. Gordon will assist Mr. Gary Harvey in the Wellington, Palmerston North and Hastings churches. The month of August concluded with a conference in Auckland attended by all the ministers in New Zealand and the South Pacific Islands. Everyone is now greatly looking forward to the holy day season beginning in September.

News From Germany The month of August was highlighted by a two-day ministerial mini-conference near Bonn on August 25th and 26th. Mr. Frank Schnee, Regional Director, and John Karlson, Bonn Office manager, both addressed the ministers on developments in Pasadena and on the Ministerial Refresher Program. Further conference sessions were devoted to PAD plans and budget for 1981, and to final preparation for the fall feasts this year.

As all the ministers' families were present, the opportunity for fellowship was much appreciated. Nine-pin bowling and refreshing plunges into the hotel swimming pool added to the relaxing atmosphere.

The church members meeting for services on August 30th responded to the ministers' reports on the Bonn mini-conference with a great deal of expectation and interest. Any news regarding Mr. Herbert W. Armstrong, his health, and his plans for the future are virtually devoured here, as the German-speaking church members exhibit a deep appreciation for the authority and responsibility of Mr. Armstrong's office.

The mail income for the month to date was up 2.5% over August 1979. Our year-to-date mail income is up 18.6% over last year.

Dutch-speaking Area Reports Mr. Bram de Bree, Regional Director for the Dutch language area sent in this report this week:

August has been a good month weather-wise and as far as growth is concerned in God's Work. The highlight of this month has been a series of three public lectures in The Hague. This series started on August 18th and continues until September 15th.

This year is also the year that The Netherlands commemorated the liberation from the Nazi occupation 35 years ago, May 1945. The first lecture focuses in on that event. It also deals with our mismanagement over these 35 years, and the last 6000, and the work God is doing through the editor of the Dutch PLAIN TRUTH, Mr. Herbert W. Armstrong. The second lecture deals with Europe in prophecy and then the third and the last lecture will deal with the World Tomorrow, and God's government on earth.

At the first lecture total attendance was 79, of which 60 people were attending for the first time. At the second lecture 99 attended, which included the same 60 attendants of the first night. Eighteen hundred people were invited in the area of The Hague. Each night gave us a 3.3% response. This is the highest response we ever had for a public lecture.

Income for August showed a 11.5% increase for the past twelve months--a 19.79% increase year to date and a 25.35% increase month to month.

Church attendance during August increased 21.8% compared to the same month a year ago. Membership increased 3.4% compared to one year ago.

ON THE WORLD SCENE

GERMAN ELECTION UPDATE Earlier this month campaigning for the October 5 West German national elections officially began. Not that it had not already started unofficially long before then.

Chancellor-challenger Franz Josef Strauss had forecast early on that the campaign would be the "dirtiest ever" in the history of the Federal Republic. It seems his prediction was correct. From all indications (based upon conditions prevailing up to September) Herr Strauss was the recipient of more abuse than his opponent, Chancellor Helmut Schmidt. He has been depicted in campaign posters (not approved by his opponents, officially at least) in various dictatorial poses. One showed Strauss, a butcher's son, slicing up a salami labeled "Freedom."

Strauss, reported TIME magazine, was to bring defamation charges against a rock group for a song containing the lyrics, "Franz Josef the pig,

Franz Josef the old pig, Franz Josef the lusting swine." Attempting to slip out of the legal action, the band is said to have retorted that Franz Josef was the name of their mascot, a cardboard pig, and that "any similarity to a living swine is purely coincidental."

Polemics and charged rhetoric aside, the campaign, according to the pollsters is still much in the incumbent's favor. In a survey conducted by der Spiegel, the West German news magazine, 73% of those polled felt Chancellor Schmidt would win. The same percentage of those polled, however, did not feel that Schmidt's party, the Social Democrats (SPD), would get an absolute majority of seats in the Bundestag, according to West Germany's rather complex apportioning formula. Therefore, the SPD needs continued support in the Bundestag from its current coalition partner, the Free Democrats. The FDP was shocked when it failed to get the necessary 5% of the vote in the state election in North Rhine-Westphalia in May. However, experts feel that this may also shock enough voters into voting FDP on October 5 to make sure they clear the 5% barrier.

Strauss' biggest problem seems to be his inability to win the hearts of his own sister-party supporters, the Christian Democrats, many of whom only grudgingly accepted him as their standard bearer. (Strauss' own party, the Christian Socialist Union--CSU--the Bavarian counterpart of the national CDU which operates in the other nine West German states.) If, in the closing weeks, Strauss can somehow win them back, he still stands a chance. It is often overlooked that the CDU-CSU candidate in the 1976 elections--the lack-luster Helmut Kohn--came within 300,000 votes of gaining an absolute majority. So, much can still happen.
